God – Hebrew wd - אֱלֹהִים – Elohim – אֱלֹהִים – El means God, אֱלֹהִים - Elohim is the plural form for GSd. Elohim is a plural noun and is also used of both the true God and the many false gods.

^⁴What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him? ^⁵For You have made him a little lower than the angels, And You have crowned him with glory and honor.

¹²'For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

EXODUS 12:12

YHWH Elohim is unique:

Psalm 86:8 Among the gods *there is* none like You, O Lord; Nor *are there any works* like Your works. **gods** – Hebrew wd - אַלֹהִים – Elohim

Psalm 95:3 For the LORD **(YHWH)** is the great God,**(EL)** And the great King above all gods. **(Elohim)**

Psalm 95:6 Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the LORD **(YHWH)** our Maker.

Psalm 95:7 For He is our God, (Elohim)

Psalm 99:5 Exalt the **LORD** our God,
And **worship** at His footstool—

He is holy.

⁸Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things. Then he said to me, "See that you do not do that. For I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book. Worship God."

¹⁵Moreover God said to Moses, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: 'The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations.'

LORD – Hebrew word – יְהֹנֶה – YHWH – means self existing one,

EXODUS 3:15

Ex. 15:3 The LORD (YHWH) is a man of war; The LORD (YHWH) is His name.

Hos. 12:5 That is, the LORD (YHWH) God of hosts. The LORD (YHWH) is His memorable name.

¹⁶Fill their faces with shame, That they may seek **Your name**, **O LORD**. (YHWH)

¹⁸That they may know that You, whose **name alone is the LORD**, (YHWH) Are the Most High over all the earth.

PSALMS 83:16 & 18

²⁴And the LORD commanded us to observe all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for **our good always**, that He might preserve us alive, as it is this day.

¹² "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³ and to keep the commandments of the LORD and His statutes which I command you today for your good?

There are three aspects of Salvation:

- Past: We are saved from the penalty of Sin Justification – free from the wrath of God. (Rom.5:1-6:11)
- Present: We are saved from the bondage of Sin Sanctification this is a process as we learn to walk in the Spirit rather than the flesh.
 (Rom.6:12-8:16)
- 3. **Future**: We are saved from the presence of sin **Glorification** this is when we are in the Presence of God in our new heavenly bodies. (Rom.8:17-25)

¹⁰Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put *Him* to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.

³⁹You **search the Scriptures**, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.

John 1:17 For the law was given through Moses, *but* grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

Eph. 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God, Eph. 2:9 not of works, lest anyone

should boast.

Grace – Greek word - χάρις – charis – means favor. Unmerited favor. Meaning this could not be earned.

¹⁶knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.

²⁴being justified freely by His **grace** through the redemption that is in Christ **Jesus**,

But we know that the law is good if one uses it lawfully, 9knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for the lawless and insubordinate, for the ungodly and for sinners, for the unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, ¹⁰for fornicators, for sodomites, for kidnappers, for liars, for perjurers, and if there is any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine,

¹⁶Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
