¹⁹But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged when I know your state. ²⁰For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state. ²¹For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus. ²²But you know his proven character, that as a son with his father he served with me in the gospel. ²³Therefore I hope to send him at once, as soon as I see how it goes with me.

PHILIPPIANS 1:1

¹⁵You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God redeemed you; therefore I command you this thing today. ¹⁶And if it happens that he says to you, ‘I will not go away from you,’ because he loves you and your house, since he prospers with you, ¹⁷then you shall take an awl and thrust it through his ear to the door, and he shall be your servant forever. Also to your female servant you shall do likewise. ¹⁸It shall not seem hard to you when you send him away free from you; for he has been worth a double hired servant in serving you six years. Then the LORD your God will bless you in all that you do.

⁴always in every [supplication] prayer of mine making request [same word for prayer] for you all with joy,

PHILIPPIANS 1:4

⁵for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now,

PHILIPPIANS 1:5

⁶being confident of this very thing,

PHILIPPIANS 1:6

cont. .. that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

PHILIPPIANS 1:6

⁷just as it is right[eous] for me to think this
of you all,

PHILIPPIANS 1:7

because [better] Even though I have you
[affectionately] in my heart,
inasmuch as both in my chains [I am
restricted by house arrest] and in the
defense [apologia] and confirmation of the
gospel, [I am confident because] you all are
partakers [while in similar circumstances]
with me of [the same] grace.

PHILIPPIANS 1:8

cont.... how greatly I long for you all with
the affection of Jesus Christ.

PHILIPPIANS 1:8

Through the tender mercy [affection] of our
God, With which the Dayspring from on
high has visited us;

LUKE 1:78

⁹And this I [also] pray [for you], that your love may abound still more and more

PHILIPPIANS 1:9

⁹In [an atmosphere of complete] knowledge and all discernment [or perceptive judgment],

PHILIPPIANS 1:9

¹¹that you may [be equipped to] approve [examine carefully] the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ [either He comes for you or you go to Him],

PHILIPPIANS 1:10

¹¹being filled with the fruits of righteousness [of doing the right steps] which are by [or through] Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

PHILIPPIANS 1:11

*Paul and Bearing Righteous Fruit,
The Teachable Life*

¹²But I want you to know, brethren, that the things which happened to me have actually turned out for the furtherance of the gospel,

PHILIPPIANS 1:12

¹³so that it has become evident to the whole palace guard, and to all the rest [in the area where I am in chains], that my chains are in Christ [not in Caesar];

PHILIPPIANS 1:13

¹⁴and most [but not all] of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.

PHILIPPIANS 1:14

¹⁵Some indeed preach Christ even from envy and strife, and some also from goodwill: ¹⁶The former preach Christ from selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my chains;

PHILIPPIANS 1:15-16

¹⁷but the latter out of love [for Jesus, Paul and the Gospel], knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel [that is why I am in chains]. ¹⁸What then is the conclusion [regarding the envious and those that love him]? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is preached; and in this [way] I rejoice, yes, and will rejoice.

PHILIPPIANS 1:17-18

¹⁹For I know that this [his chains] will turn out for my deliverance

PHILIPPIANS 1:19

cont. .. through your prayer and the supply
of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,

PHILIPPIANS 1:19

⁸For we do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, of our trouble which came to us in Asia: that we were burdened beyond measure, above strength, so that we despaired even of life. ⁹Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead,

II CORINTHIANS 1:8-9

¹⁰who delivered us from so great a death, and does deliver us; in whom we trust that He will still deliver us, ¹¹you also helping together in prayer for us, that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the gift granted to us through many.

II CORINTHIANS 1:10-11

²⁰according to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing [that has happened to me or I have done] I shall be ashamed, but with all [continued] boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by [or through] life or by [or through] death.

PHILIPPIANS 1:20

²²For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain [or an increase]. ²²But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my [continued labor] labor;

PHILIPPIANS 1:21-22

cont. ... yet what I shall choose [if it were my choice] I cannot tell. ²³For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better [for me personally]. ²⁴Nevertheless to remain in the flesh is more needful for you. ²⁵And [after a period of time in prayer, I have come out] being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for [purposes of] your progress and joy of faith, ²⁶that your rejoicing for me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ by my coming to you again.
