

Day – Hebrew word – יוֹם yom – means day as in 24 hour period or daytime as opposed to nighttime or period of time. So this word can have a variety of meanings. So context means everything.

The Hebrew word יוֹם yom

- yom is used 2301 times in the Old Testament.
- yom plus a number (used 410 times) always indicates an ordinary 24 hour day.
- The words "evening" and "morning" together
 (38 times) always indicate an ordinary day.
- Yom + "evening" or "morning" (23 times)
 always indicates an ordinary day.
- Yom + "night" (52 times) always indicates an ordinary day.

²Because He has inclined His ear to me, Therefore I will call upon Him as **long** as I live.

- Hebrew word אָרַהְּ Aw rak to make long, in reference to time.
- Hebrew word בב Rav long time,
 abundant in number, indefinite number
- Hebrew word הְרַבִּים. Ha rabim In the process of time, many days, a long period of time. This would be a much better word to use if you wanted to give us an understanding of long periods of time.

- Hebrew word hh dore means a revolution of time, an age or generation.
- Hebrew word עָדָן id dawn a season of time, time of duration.
- Hebrew word עוֹלֶם Olam long duration, distant past, distant future, an indeterminate and unending time going on into the future, everlasting, forever.

For – Hebrew word is – Ki – means for or because.



Poetic writing structure is – Subject – verb – object (SVO)

We see this in the Psalms

Narrative writing structure is – Verb – Subject – Object (VSO)

Used to give Historical accounts, facts.
