Honor – Hebrew word – **כָּבֹד** – **ka vad** –
means to weigh heavily upon, be weighty,
honored, glorified.

JOHN 19:26-27

Training is the Greek word - **παιδεία** - **pedia** – which means nurture, which is a systematic training of a child. It includes correction for wrong doing or discipline.

Admonition is a Greek word - **νουθεσία** – **noo tha sia** - means instruction
