1st Commandment – You shall have no other gods before Me - Tells us to worship the Right God which is the Only God, the LORD your God, and do not worship false gods.

¹⁰Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.'"

2nd Commandment – You shall not make for yourself a carved Image... tells you to worship the Right God in the Right way.

⁴And he received the gold from their hand, and he fashioned it with an engraving tool, and made a molded calf. Then they said, "This is your god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!"

So when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it. And Aaron made a proclamation and said, "Tomorrow is a feast to the LORD."

(YHWH)

¹Then the LORD said to Moses, "Go in to Pharaoh and tell him, 'Thus says the LORD **God** of the Hebrews: "Let My people go, that they may **serve** Me.

3rd Commandment - Exodus 20:7 - "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.

²Sing out the honor of His name; Make His praise glorious.

4th Commandment - Exodus 20: 8 "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

6th Commandment – You shall not Murder

It does not say you shall not Kill it says you shall not murder.

Kill – Hebrew word – הְרַג – haw rag – to kill, to slay.

Murder – Hebrew word – רְצַח – ratz - sakh – murder, premeditative murder, to slay or murder of someone who is innocent.

It is this Hebrew word - רְצַח – ratz - sakh that is used for the 6th commandment is You shall not Murder.



ABSTRACT: The predominance of human biological research confirms that human life begins at conception—fertilization. At fertilization, the human being emerges as a whole, genetically distinct, individuated zygotic living human organism, a member of the species Homo sapiens, needing only the proper environment in order to grow and develop. The difference between the individual in its adult stage and in its zygotic stage is one of form, not nature. This statement focuses on the scientific evidence of when an individual human life begins.






