# 2nd Coming of Christ – 3 stages

- 1. Rapture of the Church Feast of Trumpets
- 7 year Tribulation period Day of Atonement
- Return of Jesus to set up His kingdom on earth – Feast of Tabernacles

# The Feast of Trumpets, Feast of Ingathering (Rosh Hashanah)

Exodus 23:16; Lev. 23:23-25; Num. 10:10, 29:1-6

- Dates 1st day of Tishri
  (September/October)
- Purpose To announce the arrival of the 7th month of Tishri in order to prepare the people for the day of atonement.
- Fulfillment The rapture of the church (1 Cor. 15:51-2; 1 Thess. 4:16-17)

Blowing the trumpets – one word – Hebrew word – הְּרוּעָה – ter oo aw – means a blast, a blowing, a shout. So we are not told what is blasting or blowing here. The word trumpet which means Ram's horn is...

Trumpet – Hebrew word שׁוֹפֶּר – sho far – Ram's horn or curved horn of a clean animal.

Blowing the trumpets – Hebrew word – תְּצִיצְרָה – khats o tser aw – trumpet. These are silver trumpets.

**Psalm 81:3** Blow the **trumpet (Shofar)** at the time of the New Moon, **At the full moon**, on our solemn feast day.

Yet the OKJ says...

**Psalm 81:3** Blow up the **trumpet (Shofar)** in the new moon, **in the time appointed**, on our solemn feast day.

New moon is one word– Hebrew word – Kho desh – means month or new moon which begins the new month.

Moon – Hebrew word – יָבֶת yaw ray akh – means the physical moon in the sky. Used 26 times in the O.T.

Full moon – Hebrew word – בְּקֵא – keh she – means full moon or appointed time. Used only one other time and there it is translated appointed.

Proverbs 7:20 He has taken a bag of money with him, and will come home on the appointed day."

<sup>3</sup>Blow the **trumpet (Shofar)** in the time of the New Moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day.

<sup>2</sup>The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my shield and the **horn of my salvation**, my stronghold.

<sup>13</sup>And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, 14 having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. 15 Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.
