

The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur)

Lev. 23:26-32; also Lev.16:1-34; Num. 29:7-11 **Date** – 10th day of Tishri (September/October) **Purpose** - To make annual atonement for sins of Israel

Future fulfillment – Israel repentance as a nation in recognizing Jesus is their Messiah. (Zech. 12:10)

Atonement – Hebrew word – גָּבֶּר – kip poor – means atonement, expiation, redemption, which means payment. From the root word – אָבָּר – kaw fare – meaning to cover.

Afflict – Hebrew word – אֶנֶה – aw naw – means to humble, to weaken oneself.

²⁴My knees are weak through **fasting**, And my flesh is feeble from lack of fatness.

¹²"Now, therefore," says the LORD, "Turn to Me with all your heart, With **fasting**, with weeping, and with mourning."

⁹Now when much time had been spent, and sailing was now dangerous because **the Fast** was already over, Paul advised them,

⁵So the people of Nineveh believed God, **proclaimed a fast**, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest to the least of them. ⁶Then word came to the king of Nineveh; and he arose from his throne and laid aside his robe, covered himself with sackcloth and sat in ashes. ⁷And he caused it to be proclaimed and published throughout Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying, Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste anything; do not let them eat, or drink water. But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily to God; yes, let every one turn from his evil way and from the violence that is in his hands.

Forever – Hebrew word – עוֹלֶם – o lawm

- means long duration.



Scapegoat – Hebrew word – אָזָאזֵל - awza zel - means goat of departure











Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.

²⁵For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in. ²⁶And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; ²⁷For this is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins." ¹⁵I will return again to My place Till they acknowledge their offense. Then they will seek My face; In their affliction they will earnestly seek Me."

"And it shall come to pass in all the land," Says the LORD, "That two-thirds in it shall be cut off and die, But one-third shall be left in it: 91 will bring the one-third through the fire, Will refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them. I will say, 'This is My people'; And each one will say, 'The LORD is my God.' "

¹⁰"And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn. ¹¹In that day there shall be a great mourning in Jerusalem, like the mourning at Hadad Rimmon in the plain of Megiddo. ¹²And the land shall mourn, every family by itself: the family of the house of David by itself, and their wives by themselves; the family of the house of Nathan by itself, and their wives by themselves;
