


Hebraic Feast and Holy Days



¹⁶So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, ¹⁷which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.

Feast of Tabernacles: Sukkot

Lev. 23:33-43; Num. 29:12-39; Deut. 16:13-17, 31:10-13

Dates – 15th -21st of Tishri, with an 8th day added as a climax to all the feasts

Purpose - To commemorate God's protection during the wilderness wanderings and to rejoice in the harvest.

70 (7x10) bulls + 14 (7x2) rams + 98 (14x7) lambs = 182 (26x7) 336 tenths of ephah of flour (48x7)

LORD empty-handed. ¹⁷Every man *shall* give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD your God which He has given you.

The Torah - The written law of Moses contained in the first five books of O.T. but the Jews also believed that Moses also gave other oral revelation which was not written down.

Booths – Hebrew word – סֵכְּה – Soo kaw – means booths or hut. However the Jews say Sukkot because this is the original Hebrew word for booths that we see Gen.33:17.

Genesis 33:17 And Jacob journeyed to Succoth, built himself a house, and made booths for his livestock. Therefore the name of the place is called Succoth.

Succoth – Hebrew word – סְבּוֹת - Sukkot – means booths.

So this actually reads...Gen.33:17 - And Jacob journeyed to Sukkot, built himself a house, and made Sookaw for his livestock. Therefore, the name of that place is called Sukkot.

Talmud - Oral revelation by Moses not written down

Mishna – Text


Gemara - commentary

The Rabbi's and Pharisees said "the written word is water, but the interpretation, and that which is added to it is wine."

They would go on to say. "If the scribes say the right is left, hear them."

¹³Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"),

¹⁷So the whole assembly of those who had returned from the captivity made booths and sat under the booths; for since the days of Joshua the son of Nun until that day the children of Israel had not done so. And there was very great gladness.

Word – logos – the reason of God

Flesh – σάρξ - sarx – human form and nature in all weakness and ability to sin

Dwelt - σκηνόω - sken nah o, skay-no´-o; from 4636; to tent or encamp, or to tabernacle. This is the same word used in the O.T. for Tabernacle.

¹⁶And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. ¹⁷And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain. 18 If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which the LORD strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. 19This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.
