



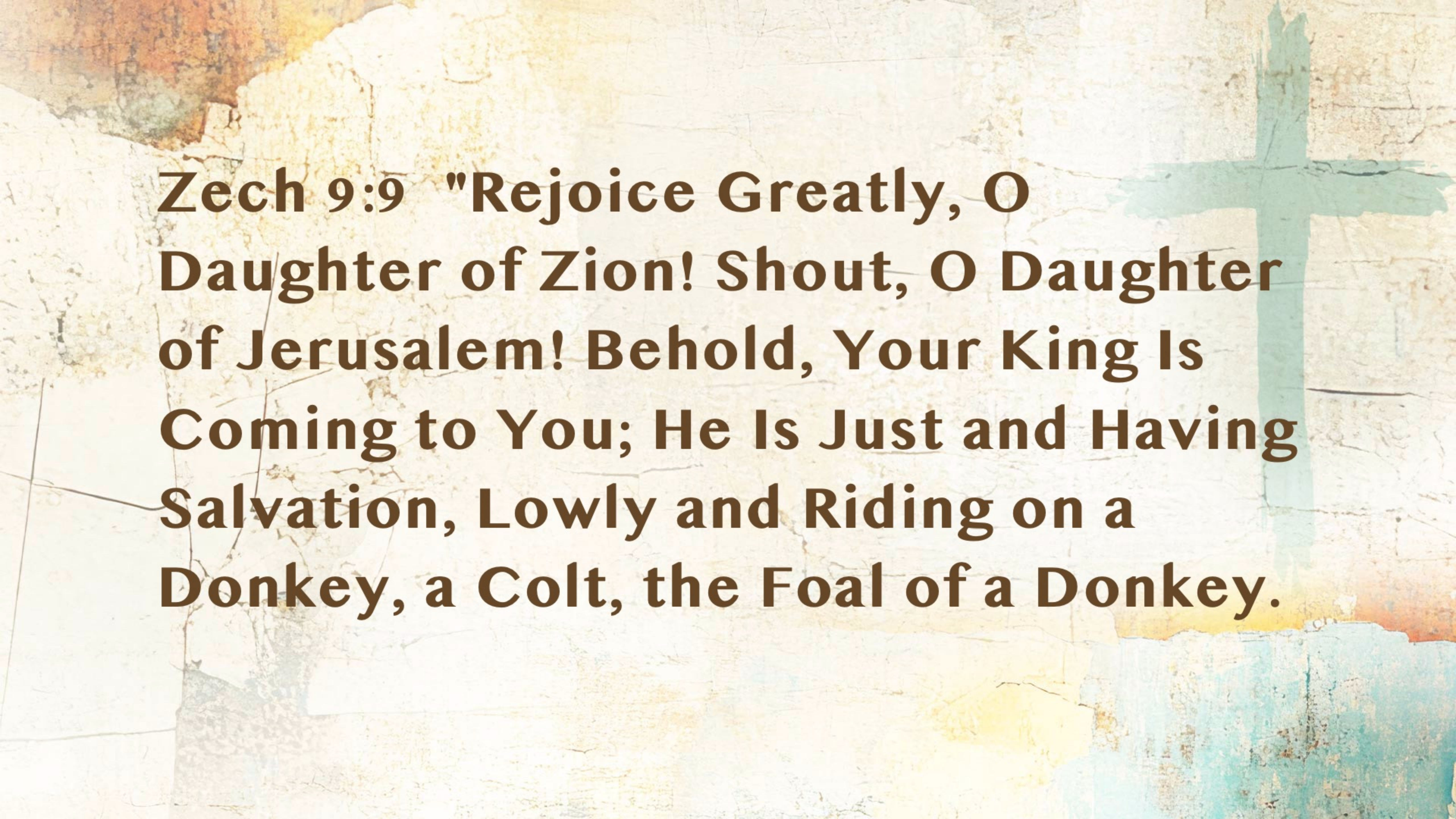

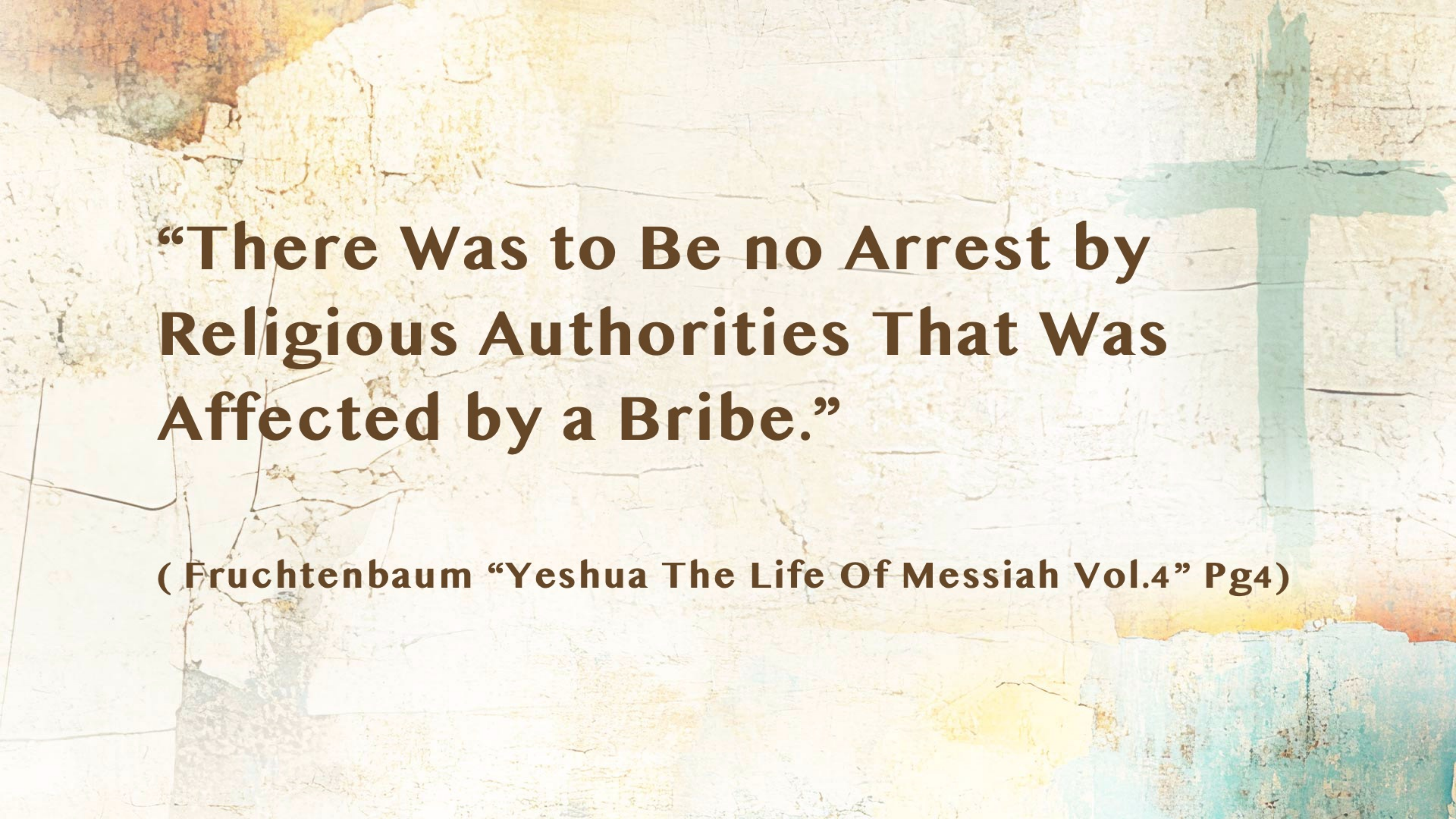
**Zech 9:9 "Rejoice Greatly, O

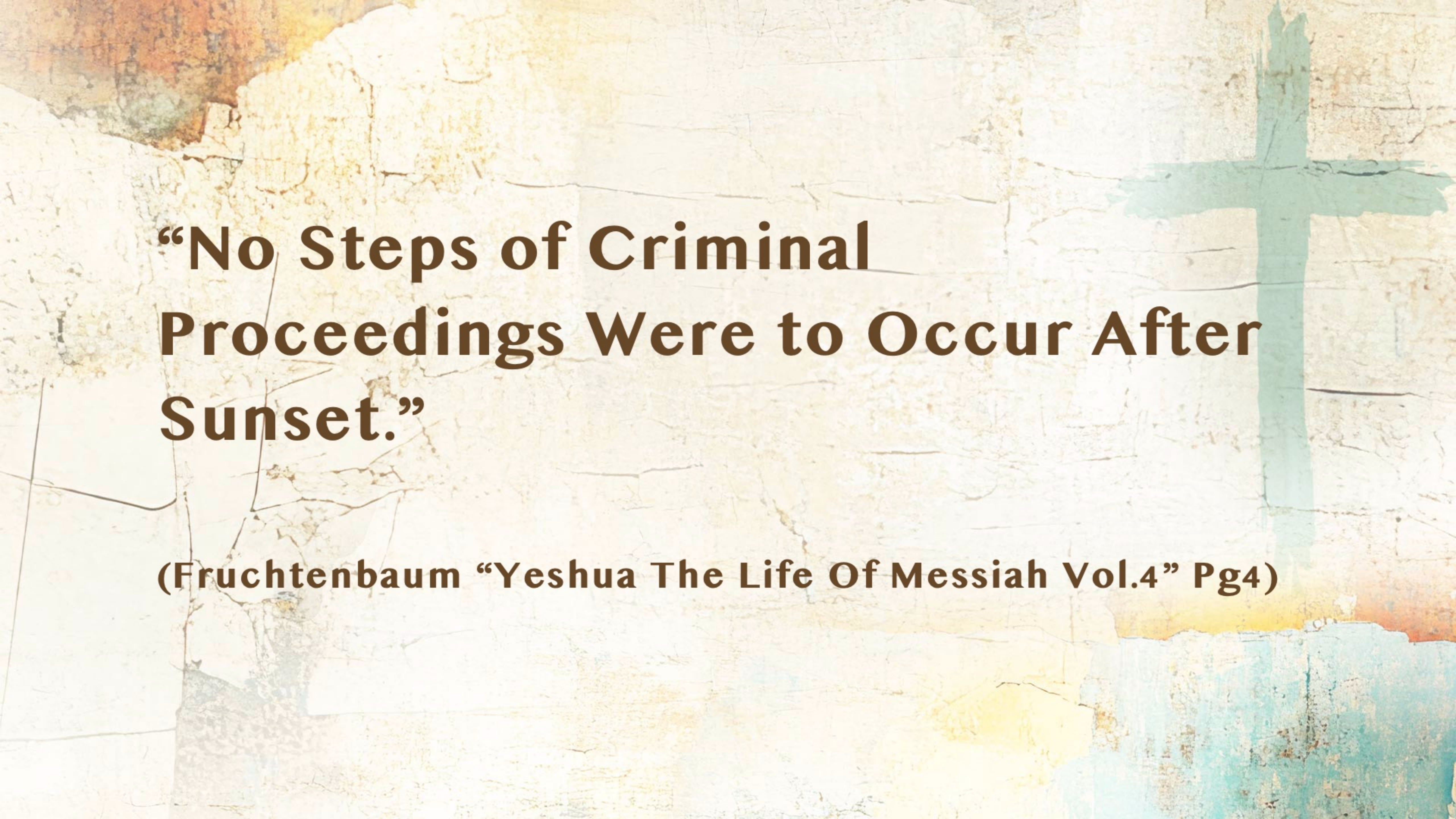

Which Means 600 Men.**

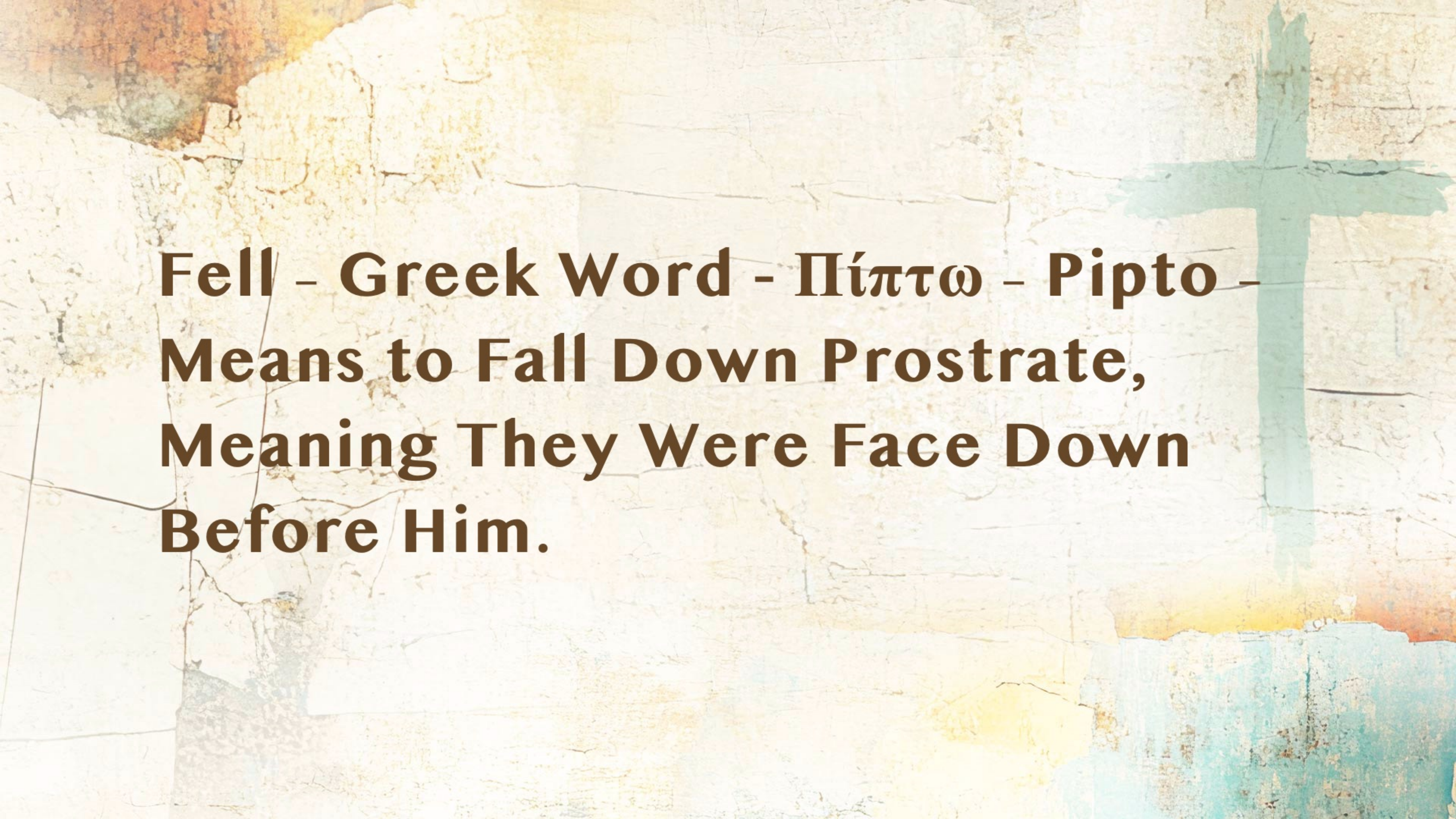
**¹Then the Whole Multitude of Them

Means to Fall Down Prostrate,
Meaning They Were Face Down
Before Him.**

⁴⁹ Immediately He Went Up to Jesus and Said, “Greetings, Rabbi!” and Kissed Him.

**Sword - Greek Word - *Μάχαιρα* -
Mahk Khee Rah - Means Long
Ceremonial Knife With a Single
Cutting Edge. Used for Cutting up
Animals.**

⁴⁹When Those Around Him Saw What Was Going to Happen, They Said to Him, “Lord, Shall We Strike With the Sword?” ⁵⁰And One of Them Struck the Servant of the High Priest and Cut Off His Right Ear. ⁵¹But Jesus Answered and Said, “Permit Even This.” and He Touched His Ear and Healed Him.

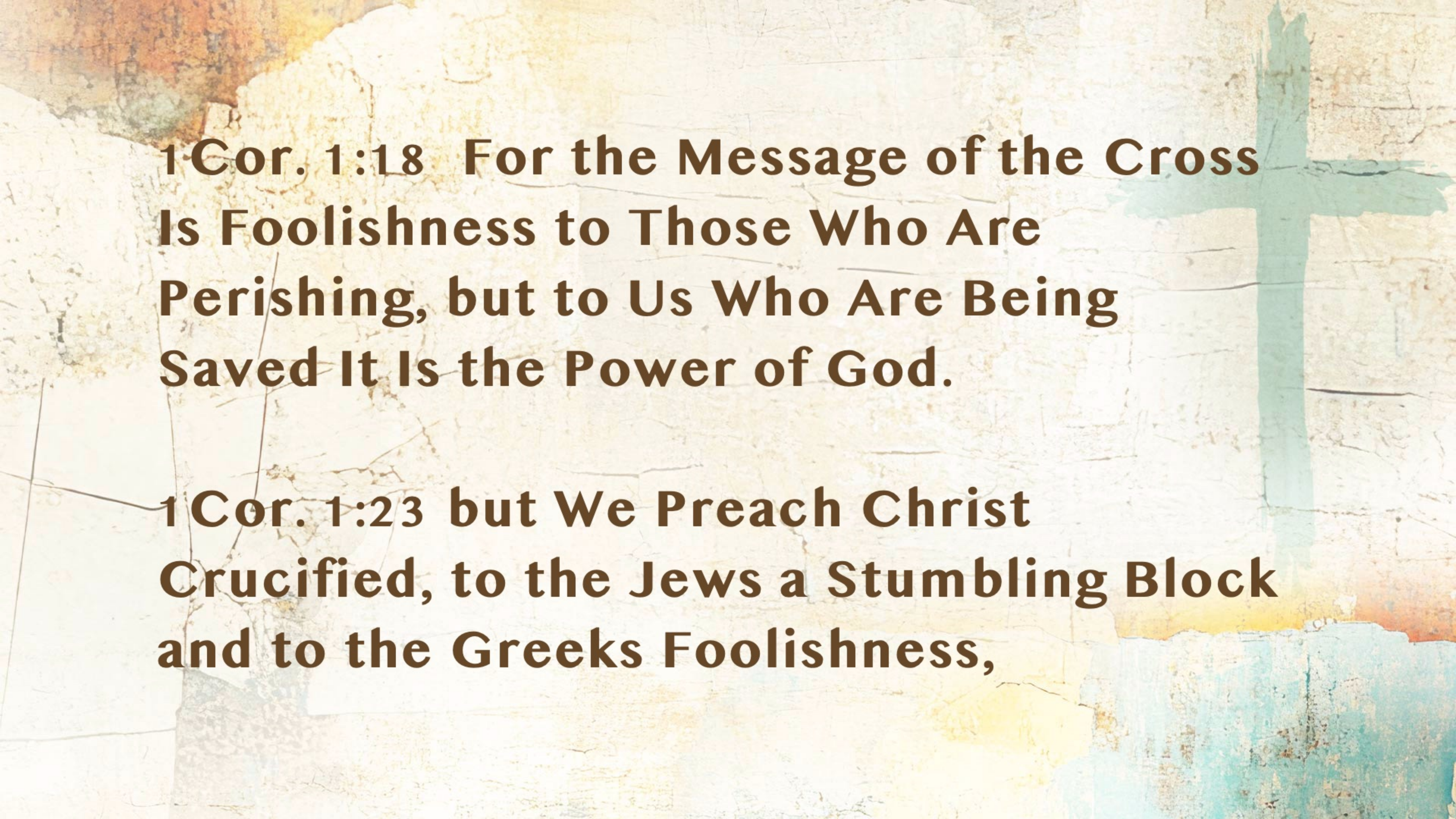

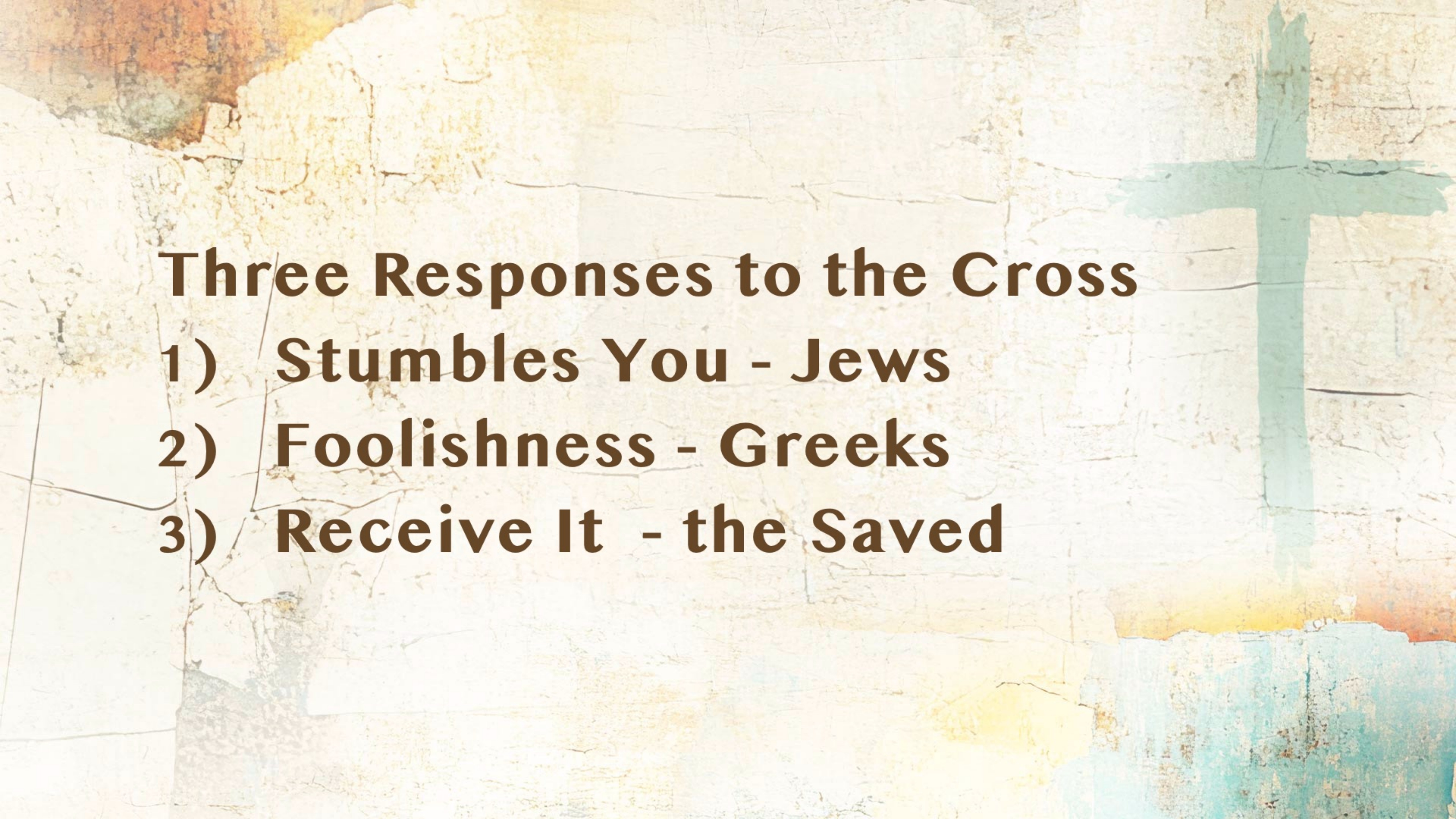
