
# Not a sweet aroma and mandatory offerings

## The Sin Offering is about our sin nature The Trespass Offering is about the situation our sin caused

Sin – Hebrew word – קטא – Khaw taw – means to miss the way or miss the mark

Unintentionally – Hebrew word – שְׁגָגָה – sh ga gah – means ignorance, unawares, through error or inadvertently.

Priest sins – vs 3-12
The nation sins – vs 13-21
The ruler sins – vs 22-26
Common people sin – vs 27-35
Unintentional sins – Lev.5:1-4

Common people – Hebrew word - עָם – am ha'arets – means people of the land.

Lamb – Hebrew word – בֶּבֶשׁ – kev ves – means lamb but comes from a root word which means to dominate.

## The Sin Offering is about our sin nature The Trespass Offering is about the situation our sin caused

Lev.5:14-19 – Trespasses against God Lev.6:1-7 – Trespasses against others Trespass – Hebrew word – מֵעֵל – ma al – means unfaithful or treacherous act against God or man. It comes from a primitive root that means to cover up. In the figurative sense it is seen as acting covertly and thus treacherously.

Offering – Hebrew word – אָשָׁם – asham – means offense, fault, guilt, restitution.

<sup>28</sup>"At the end of every third year you shall bring out the tithe of your produce of that year and store it up within your gates. 29 And the Levite, because he has no portion nor inheritance with you, and the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who are within your gates, may come and eat and be satisfied, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hand which you do.

<sup>1</sup>My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. <sup>2</sup>And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

Lying – Hebrew word – בְּחֵשׁ – Kaw Khash – means deception to deal falsely. <sup>15</sup>But Sarah denied it, saying, "I did not laugh," for she was afraid. And He said, "No, but you did laugh!"

"If a man delivers to his neighbor money or articles to keep, and it is stolen out of the man's house, if the thief is found, he shall pay double. 8 If the thief is not found, then the master of the house shall be brought to the judges to see whether he has put his hand into his neighbor's goods.

<sup>23</sup>Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, <sup>24</sup>leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift. <sup>18</sup>If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.

14"For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.
