

- Exodus 19:1 3rd month, 15th day arrive at Mt
 Sinai
- Exodus 40:17 1st month, 1st day, of the 2nd year – Tabernacle is raised up This equals 9 months and 15 days
- Numbers 1:1 2nd month, 1st day of the 2nd year, 30 days after Tabernacle raised
- Numbers 10:11 2nd month, 20th day leave
 Mt Sinai for the Promised Land.

Take – Hebrew word – נְשָׂא – nasa – means to lift up.

Census – Hebrew word – רֹאשׁ – roshe – means head. This means to lift up the head or in other words take a head count.

^⁴He counts the number of the stars; He calls them all by name.

32...you know that the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, and gives it to whomever He chooses."

Plague – Hebrew word – גֶּגֶף – neh'-ghef

- means blow, striking, plague.

¹² For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD. ¹³Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.'

²So the king said to Joab the commander of the army who was with him, "now go throughout all the tribes of Israel, from Dan to Beersheba, and count the people, that I may know the number of the people." (Pride) ³And Joab said to the king, "now may the LORD your God add to the people a hundred times more than there are, and may the eyes of my lord the king see it. But why does my lord the king desire this thing?"

¹⁵So the LORD sent a plague (neh'-ghef) upon Israel from the morning till the appointed time. From Dan to Beersheba seventy thousand men of the people died.

Ransom – Hebrew word - גֹּפֶר – ko fer – means covering or pitch as in the pitch used to seal the Ark of Noah or figuratively a redemption-price which it means here.





²⁸Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
²⁹Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

¹¹For no other **foundation** can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.


¹³Christ has **redeemed** us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "*Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree*").

¹⁹Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? ²⁰ For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.






Tabernacle

⁸He made the laver of bronze and its base of bronze, from the bronze mirrors of the serving women who assembled at the door of the tabernacle of meeting.

¹There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Bathed is Greek word – $\lambda o \dot{\omega} \omega$ – **louo** meaning to bathe completely, from head to toe.

Wash is Greek word – **νίπτω** – **nipto** – meaning to clean ceremonially hands and feet.

⁸If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
