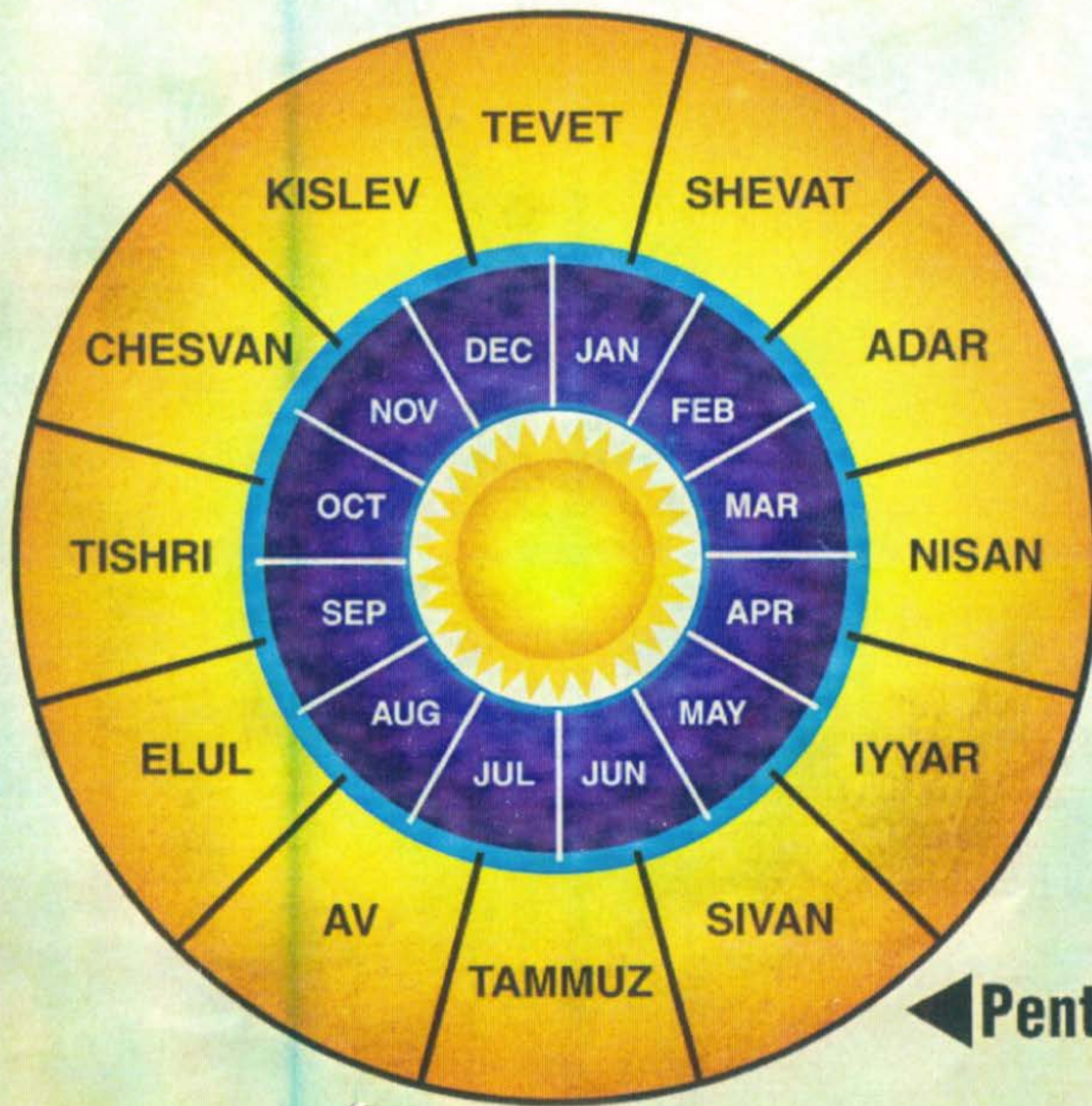


Covenant – Hebrew word – **בְּרִית** – **berit**

¹¹“And it shall be, when the LORD brings you into the land of the Canaanites, as He swore to you and your fathers, and gives it to you,

¹²that you shall set apart to the LORD all that open the womb, that is, every firstborn that comes from an animal which you have; the males *shall* be the LORD's.

¹³But every firstborn of a donkey you shall redeem with a lamb; and if you will not redeem *it*, then you shall break its neck. And all the firstborn of man among your sons you shall redeem.

Set apart – Hebrew word – עָבַר – **aw**
vare – means to pass over, cross, cross
over, march over, overflow, go over.

²⁶For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. ²⁷For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

GALATIANS 3:26-29

²⁸There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

²⁹And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and **heirs** according to the promise.

Morsel – Hebrew word – פַּת – **pat** –
means piece or fragment or bit. In other
words it means I will get you a piece of
bread.

Cakes – Hebrew word – עֶגֶה – oo gaw –
means a disc of bread, or bread that is
round in shape.
