

Shone – Hebrew word – קבר - kaw-ran – means to shine, to send out rays or to display or grow horns, be horned.

³⁰I will praise the name of God with a song, And will magnify Him with thanksgiving.

³¹This also shall please the LORD better than an ox or bull, Which has horns and hooves.









1Cor. 15:9 For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

Eph. 3:8 To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,

1Tim. 1:15 This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief.

Covenant – Hebrew word – בְּרִית – berit – means a treaty, an alliance, this would be a contractual agreement between God and the nation of Israel.

For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God.

^⁴For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Rom. 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

Rom. 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

⁶³It is the **Spirit** who gives **life**; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are **spirit**, and they are **life**.

"The glory on the face of Moses must give way to the glory in another face"

¹⁶So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths,

¹⁷which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.

When God gave the law to Israel, He was using Israel as a sample of the human race. Israel failed and so Paul applies this failing to all of humanity. It's like when you take a test tube of water from the well, a testing of that sample of water shows contamination, thus it means the whole well is polluted.

"it is the straight-edge of the Law that shows us how crooked we are. () "the law is not there to justify but to terrify"

¹⁰For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all.

²⁴Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

²⁵But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.

⁷The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;

¹²But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

³For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, ⁴who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

⁵For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, ⁶who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time,
