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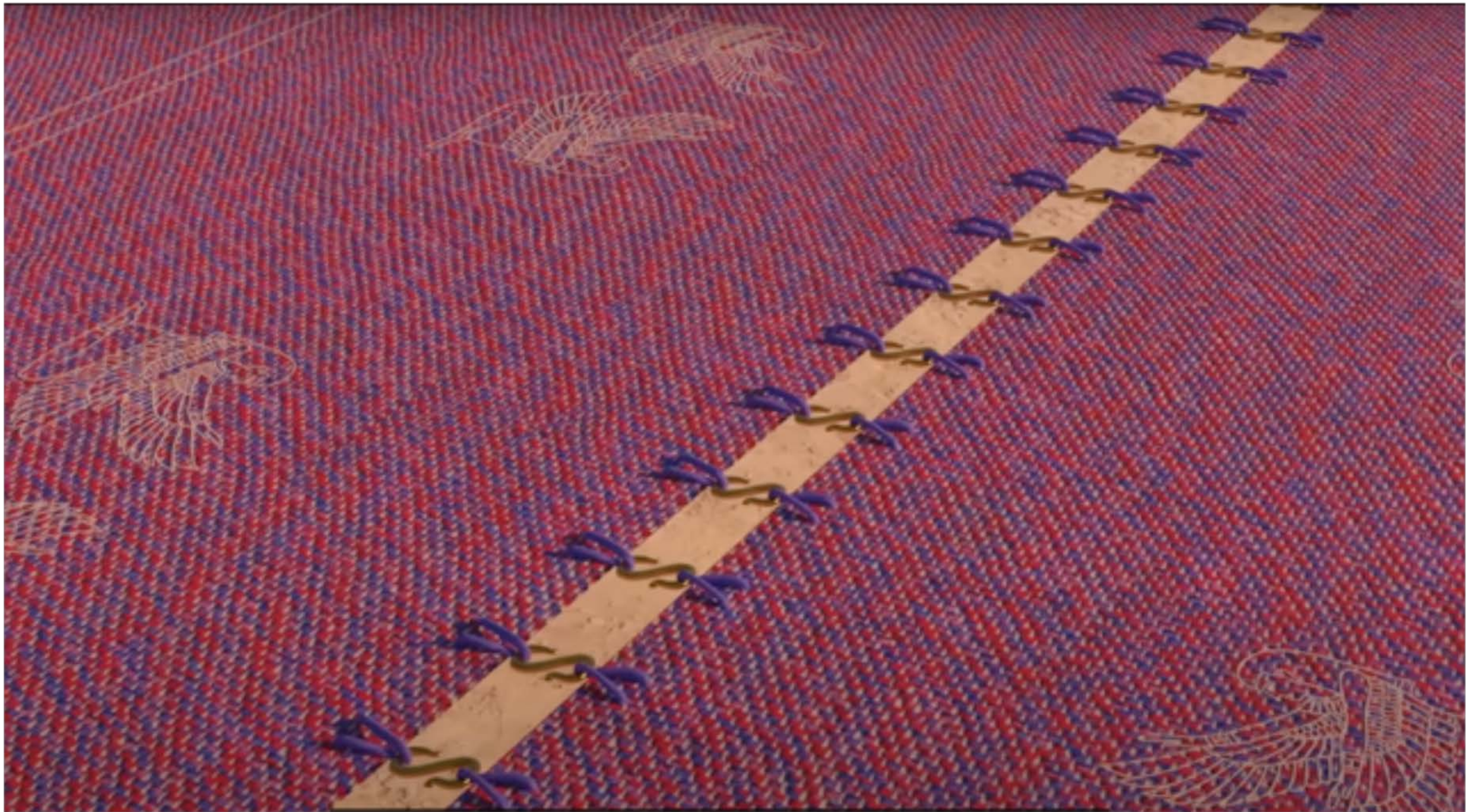
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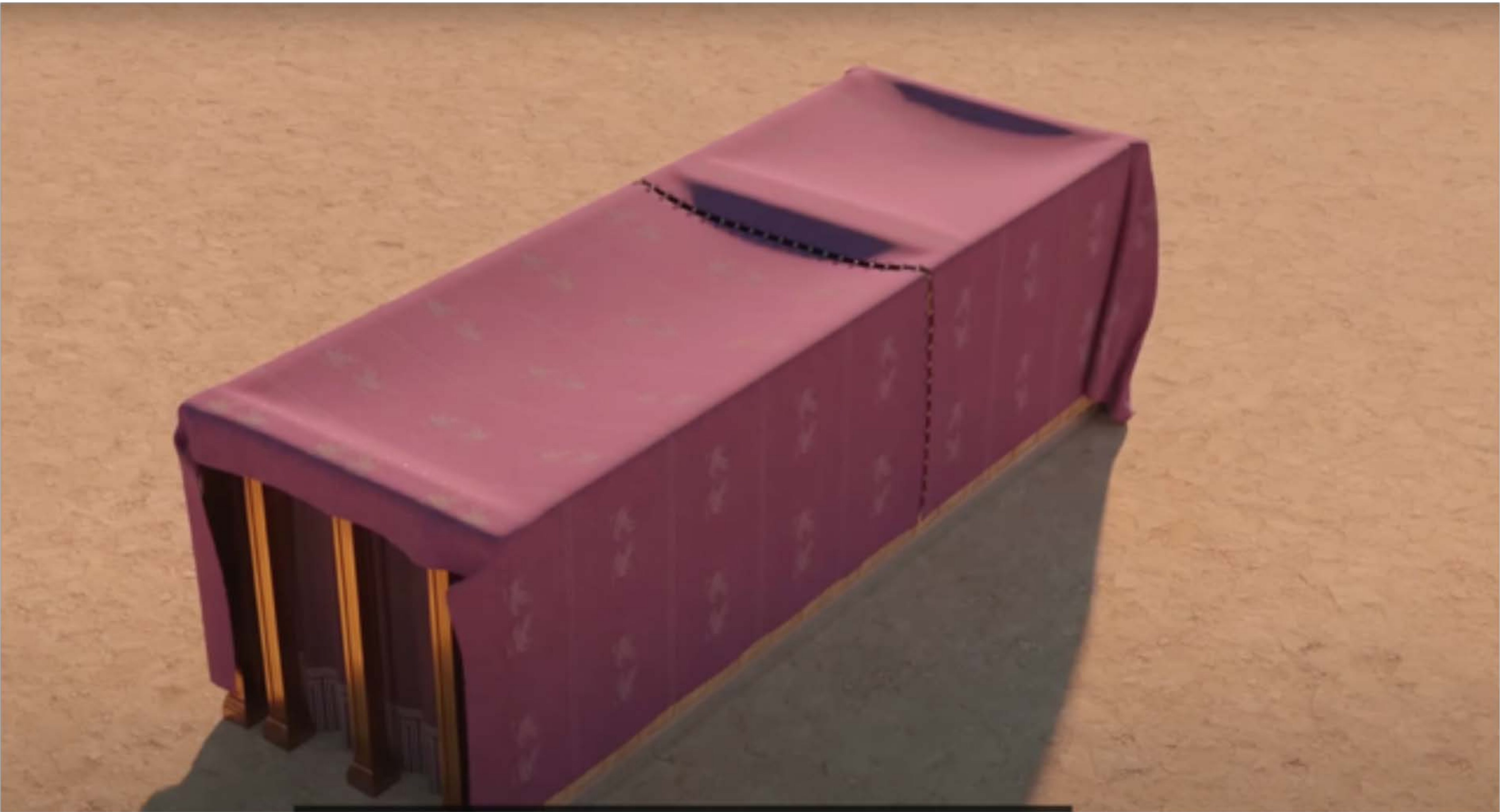
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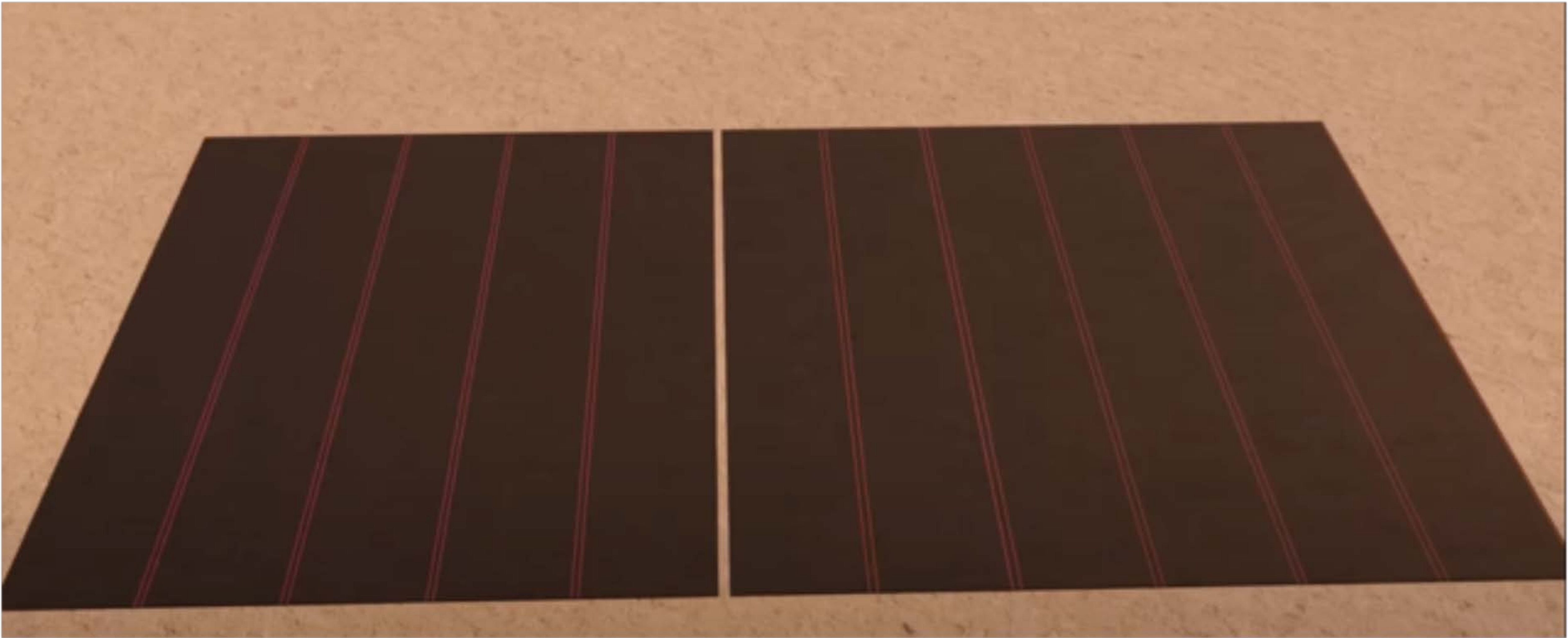
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The Tabernacle 4 Coverings – Outside looking in: Its Jesus

Jesus becoming sin for us

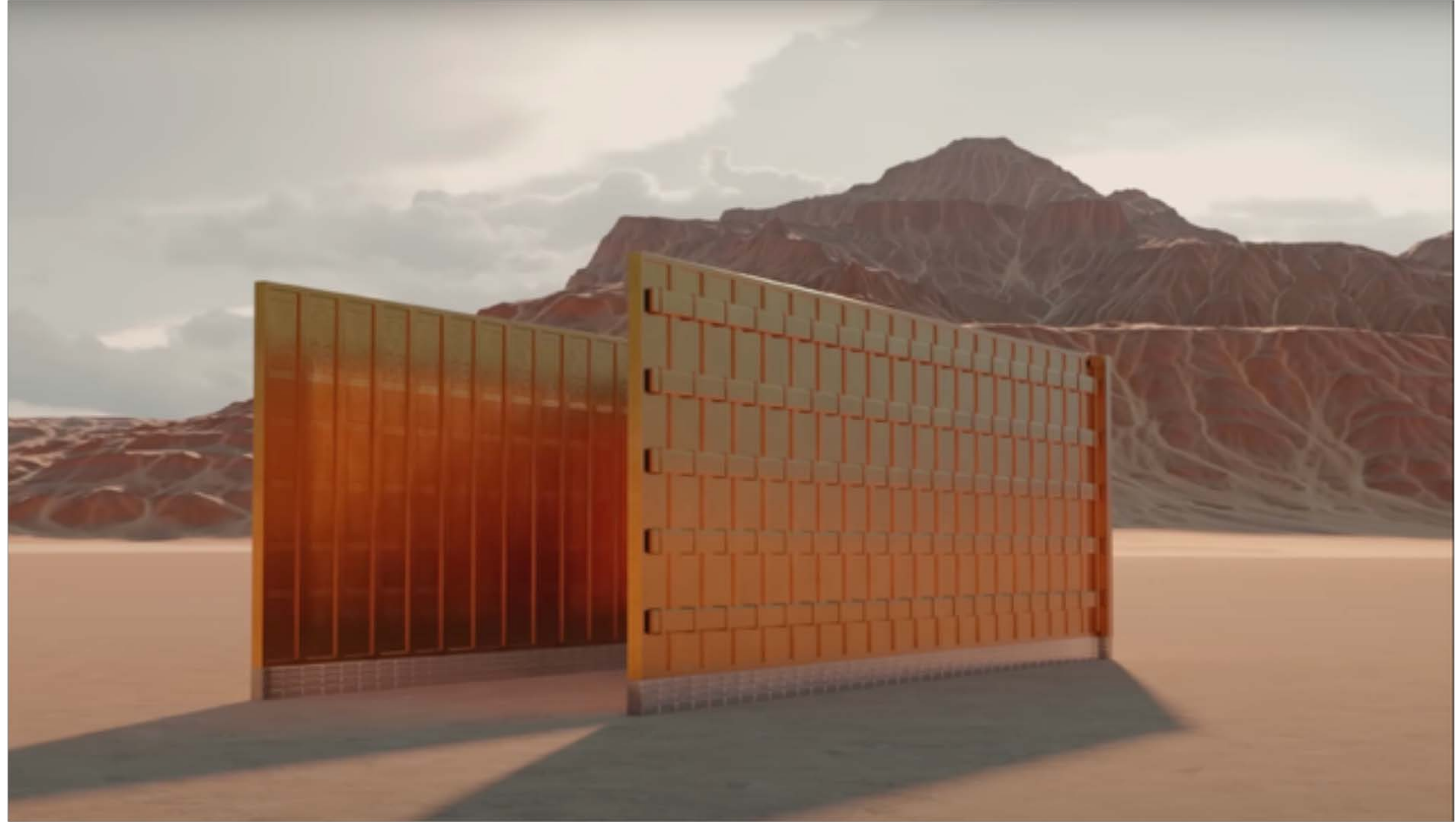
2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Hebrews 10:12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God.







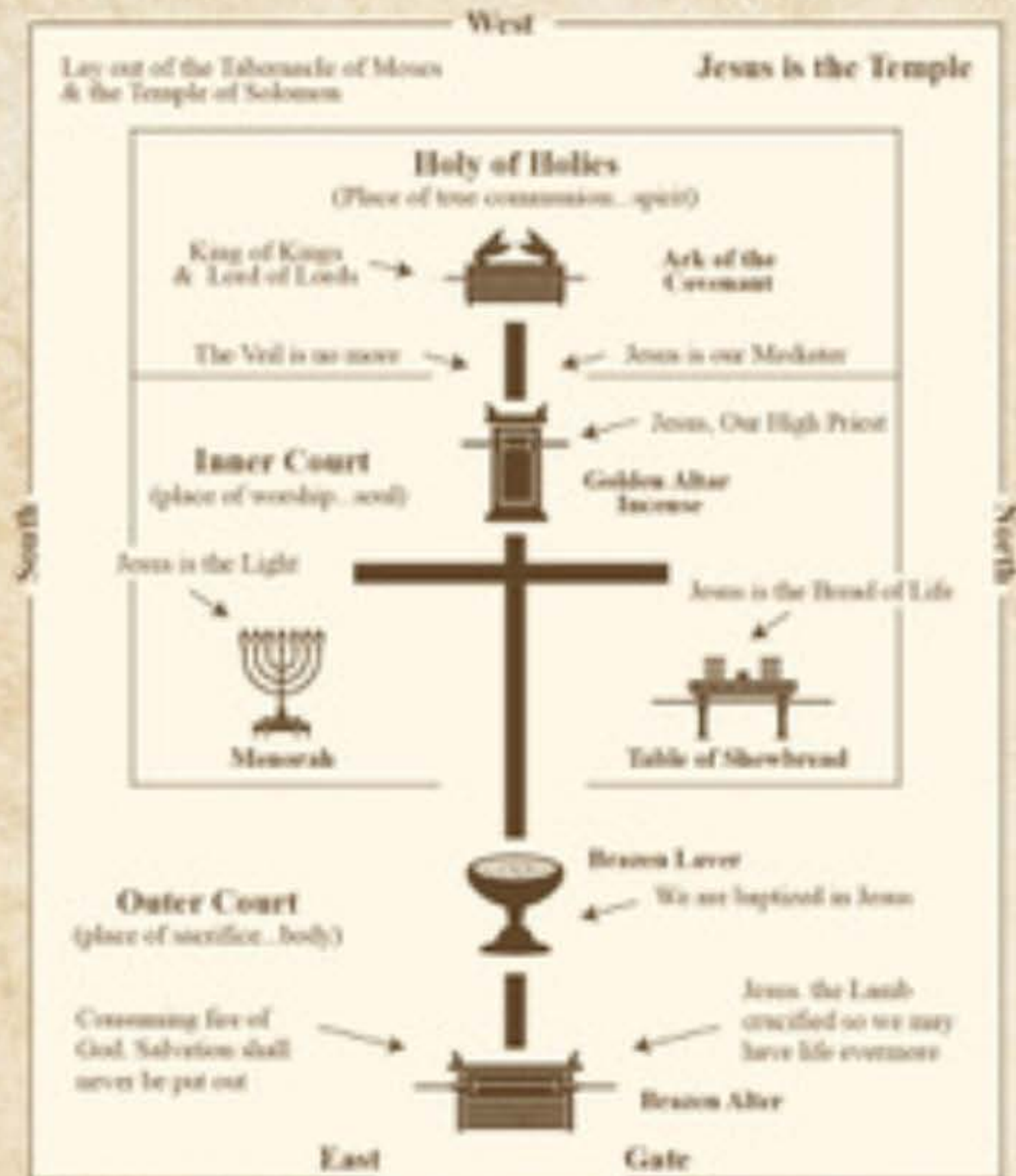
