¹I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called,

¹⁸Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. ¹⁹Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter toward them. ²⁰Children, obey your parents in all things, for this is well pleasing to the Lord. ²¹Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.

²²Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God.

²with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love,

²⁹Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

⁵Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

⁸And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins."

³endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

³⁶But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.

^⁴There is **one** body and **one** Spirit, just as you were called in **one** hope of your calling; ^⁵**one** Lord, **one** faith, one baptism; ^⁵**one** God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

¹³For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.

Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?"

³⁷Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

³⁸So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him. Now when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught Philip away, so that the eunuch saw him no more; and he went on his way rejoicing.

⁷But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.

⁸Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men."

⁹(Now this, "He ascended"—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth {to the righteous side Sheol} 10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) {Concerning his body} ¹¹And He (Jesus) Himself gave some (Men) to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers,

¹²for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying {building up} of the body of Christ,

¹²Even so you, since you are zealous for spiritual gifts, let it be for the edification of the church that you seek to excel.

¹⁸But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased.

¹Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.

¹⁴If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.

²⁸just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

¹Imitate me, just as I also imitate Christ.
