Ithamar – Hebrew word - אֵיתָמָר - **eeth
aw mawr** – means land of palms.

¹“And **Bezalel** and **Aholiab**, and every gifted artisan in whom the LORD has put wisdom and understanding, to know how to do all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, shall do according to all that the LORD has commanded.”

EXODUS 36:1

- **Purple** – Matthew – the Royalty of Christ as King
- **Scarlet** – Mark – the Suffering Servant
- **White** (Fine Linen) – Luke – The Sinless Man
- **Blue** – John – Son of God from Heaven

Traditional representation of Aaron's breastplate. The Bible does not record the order of the names to be inscribed on the stones, so that identification of a tribe with a certain stone is guesswork.





Linen – Hebrew word – **טָבֵד** – **bod** –
means linen, white linen.

¹⁴Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.
