The early church father **Irenaeus** (ca. A.D. 130–200) was a disciple of Polycarp (ca. A.D. 70–160), who was a disciple of the Apostle John, and he testified on Polycarp's authority that John wrote the gospel during his residence at Ephesus in Asia Minor when he was advanced in age, near the end of his life. (Against Heresies 2.22.5; 3.1.1)

Clement of Alexandria (ca. A.D. 150–215) wrote that John, aware of the facts set forth in the other gospels and being moved by the Holy Spirit, composed a “spiritual gospel” (see Eusebius’ Ecclesiastical History 6.14.7)

means to call attention to something very
important. Do not neglect this.

- 1) **John 1:42** Andrew brings his brother Simon, who is Peter.
- 2) **John 6:8-9** – it is Andrew who brings the little boy to Jesus who has the 5 loaves and two small fish at the feeding of the 5,000.
- 3) In **John 12:22** – Andrew and Philip bring some enquiring Greeks to Jesus.

Jacob – Hebrew word – יַעֲקֹב – **Ya ah kov** – means heel catcher or supplanter in a deceitful sense.

Israel – Hebrew word – יִשְׂרָאֵל – **Yis raw ale** – means God prevails.
