Jesus predicts 3 times His death

1. Matthew 16:21, 17:22-23, 20:18-19
2. Mark 8:31, 9:31, 10:33-34
3. Luke 9:22, 9:44, 18:31-33

²¹From that time Jesus began to show to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day.

MATTHEW 16:21

²²Now while they were staying in Galilee, Jesus said to them, “The Son of Man is about to be betrayed into the hands of men,²³ and they will kill Him, and the third day He will be raised up.” And they were exceedingly sorrowful.

MATTHEW 17:22-23

¹⁸“Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribes; and they will condemn Him to death, ¹⁹and deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock and to scourge and to crucify. And the third day He will rise again.”

MATTHEW 20:18-19

Suffered – Greek word – **πάσχω** – **pas kho** –
means to be rejected and afflicted all of which
brings a sensation of pain.

Mocked – Greek word – **ἐμπαίζω** – **empaizo** – means to jeer, to deride, to ridicule, to laugh at, make fun of.

³⁹“But you have a custom that I should release someone to you at the Passover. Do you therefore want me to release to you the King of the Jews?”

⁴⁰Then they all cried again, saying, “Not this Man, but Barabbas!” Now Barabbas was a robber.

JOHN 18:39-40

¹So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him.

JOHN 19:1

Scourged – Greek word – **μαστιγόω** – **mastigoo**
– means – to flog or scourge.

¹³Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently;
He shall be exalted and extolled and be very
high. ¹⁴Just as many were astonished at you, So
His visage was marred more than any man, And
His form more than the sons of men;

ISAIAH 52:13-14

¹So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him.
²And the soldiers twisted a crown of thorns and put it on His head, and they put on Him a purple robe.
³Then they said, "Hail, King of the Jews!"
And they struck Him with their hands.

JOHN 19:1-3

²⁹When they had twisted a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand. And they bowed the knee before Him and mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!"
³⁰Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.

¹⁴Now it was the Preparation Day of the Passover, and about the sixth hour. And he said to the Jews, "Behold your King!"

¹⁷And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha, ¹⁸where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center.

JOHN 19:17-18

Crucify

The word excruciating derives from the Latin "excruciare," meaning "to torture severely." It is a compound word formed from the prefix "ex-" (out of) and the root "cruciare" (to crucify).

³⁹And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads ⁴⁰and saying, "You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross."

MATTHEW 27:39-40

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

⁴¹Likewise the chief priests also, mocking with the scribes and elders, said, ⁴²“He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him. ⁴³He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said, ‘I am the Son of God.’ ”

³⁶The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine,

LUKE 23:36

³⁶The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine, ³⁷and saying, "If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself."

Matthew 27:44 Even the robbers who were crucified with Him reviled Him with the same thing.

Mark 15:32b.... Even those who were crucified with Him reviled Him.

Lord here is the Greek word - **κύριος** – **kurios** – this is a title of honor. An expression of respect and reverence, with which servants greet their master
