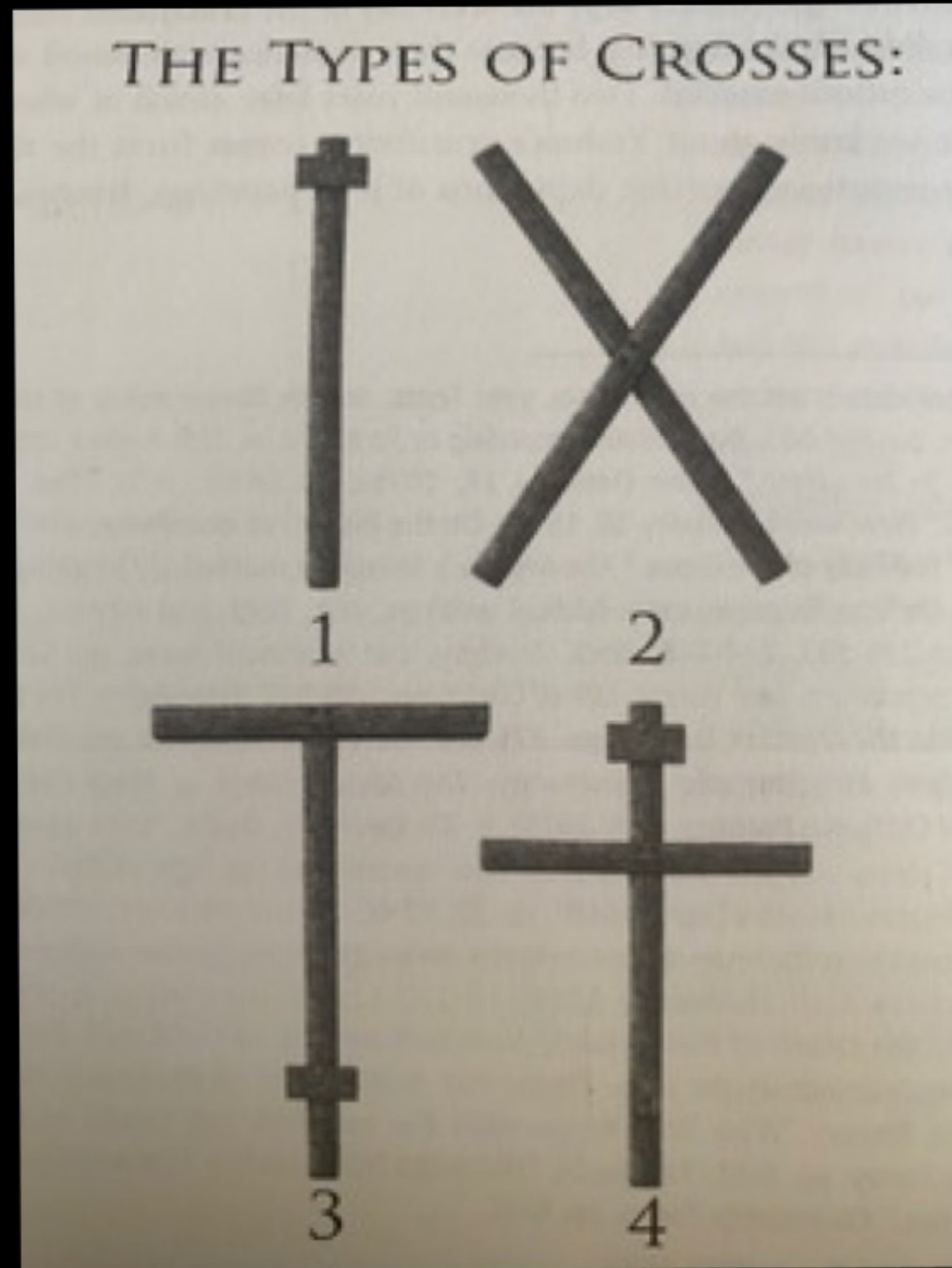
⁴Then the serpent said to the woman, “You will not surely die.

JOHN 19:30

“It is Finished” – Greek word - **Τετέλεσται** –
Tetelestai – Paid in full, Accomplished, to bring to
a close, meaning to bring to a close all that is
required for payment of sin.

Principalities – Greek Wd - ἀρχή - **ar khay** – means beginning or originator, the first person or thing in a series, the leader. In other words Satan who is the originator of sin.

Powers – Greek word - **ἐξουσία** - **ex-oo-see'-ah** – means power of authority, the right to exercise power.

Disarmed – Greek wd - **ἀπεκδύομαι** - **ap-ek-doo'-om-ahee** means a separation from what is put off, to strip off for one's self (for one's own advantage).

Spectacle – Greek word - *δειγματίζω* - **digh-mat-id'-zo** - Means to make an example of, to show as an example.

Public – Greek word - *παρρησία* - **par-rhay-see'-ah** - openly, frankly, without concealment.

Garden – Hebrew word – גַּן – **gan** – means a garden enclosed, with plants and trees. It speaks of Life.

²²Then the LORD God said, “Behold, the man has become like one of Us, to know good and evil. And now, lest he put out his hand and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever” —
²³therefore the LORD God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.
