*Talmud is oral and written comments about the Torah

The Rabbi's and Pharisees said **“the written word is water, but the interpretation, and that which is added to it is wine.”**

They would go on to say. **“If the scribes say the right is left, hear them.”**



“Tradition is a fence around the law.” (Aboth 3.14)

1 Chronicles 29:10 Therefore David blessed the LORD before all the assembly; and David said: “Blessed are You, LORD God of Israel, **our Father**, forever and ever.

Isaiah. 63:16b···You, O LORD, are **our Father**;···.

Isaiah 64:8a But now, O LORD, You are **our Father**;···..

6 claims that Jesus is God

1. Vs 19-21 – He does what the Father does in perfect harmony
2. Vs 21 – Jesus imparts Life
3. Vs 22- Judgement given to the Son
4. Vs 23- Both the Father and the Son get equal honor
5. Vs 24- Jesus has the power to provide eternal life
6. Vs 25-29 – Jesus has the power to bring about the resurrection of the dead.

It was the Religious leaders who taught that God alone was the keeper of three things:

- 1) **The key to heaven** – which he uses when rain falls - **Deuteronomy 28:12 The LORD will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season,...**
- 2) **The key to the womb** – which He uses to have couples conceive - **Genesis 30:2 And Jacob's anger was aroused against Rachel, and he said, "Am I in the place of God, who has withheld from you the fruit of the womb?"**
- 3) **The key to the grave** – which He uses to bring people back to life like He shows in - **Ezekiel 37:5 Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones: "Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live.**

Psalm 50:6 Let the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is Judge.

Ecclesiastes 3:17 I said in my heart, “God shall judge the righteous and the wicked,

Psalm 58:11 So that men will say, “Surely there is a reward for the righteous; mSurely He is God who judges in the earth.”

Ecclesiastes 12:14 For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.

Honor – Greek word - **τιμάω** – **tim ah o** –
means to honor, to give value.

¹⁷“Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again.

¹⁸No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father.”

Jesus baptism

- **Matthew 3:17** And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, “This is My **beloved Son**, in whom I am well pleased.”

At Mount of Transfiguration

- **Mark 9:7** And a cloud came and overshadowed them; and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, “This is **My beloved Son**. Hear Him!”

Search – Greek word - *ἐραυνάω* -**er-**
yoo-nah ´ -**o**; means to seek, to search,
examine, to investigate.
