¹⁵And in those days Peter stood up in the midst of the disciples (altogether the number of names was about a hundred and twenty), and said, ¹⁶“Men and brethren, this Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke before by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus; ¹⁷for he was

numbered with us **[the 12]** and obtained a part in this ministry.”¹⁸ (Now this man purchased a field with the wages of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst open in the middle and all his entrails gushed out.¹⁹ And it became known to all those dwelling in Jerusalem; so that field is called in their own language, Akel Dama, that is, Field of Blood.)

²⁰“For it is written in the Book of Psalms:
‘Let his dwelling place be desolate, And
let no one live in it’; and, ‘Let another take
his office.’

²¹“Therefore, of these men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us, ²²beginning from the baptism of John to that day when He was taken up from us, one of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection.”²³ And they proposed two: Joseph called Barsabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias.

²⁴And they prayed and said, “You, O Lord, who know the hearts of all, show which of these two You have **[already]** chosen ²⁵to take part in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas by transgression fell, that he might go to his own place.” ²⁶And they cast their lots, and the lot fell on Matthias. And he was numbered with the eleven apostles.

But Barnabas took him and brought him to the **[twelve]** apostles. And he declared to them how he **had seen the Lord on the road**, and that **He had spoken to him**, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.

Bi-Vocational Prophets?

A Dead Sea scroll from the first century BC includes a note detailing David's compositions made "through prophecy given him from before the Most High," attributing to him 3,600 "praises," 446 "songs" for daily and special worship, and four "songs" to sing with harp or lyre over those afflicted by evil spirits—totaling 4,050 pieces.

¹⁴Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of **the twelve apostles** of the Lamb.

²⁷ And in these days **prophets** came from Jerusalem to Antioch. ²⁸ Then one of them, named **Agabus**, stood up and showed by the Spirit that there was going to be a great famine throughout all the world, which also happened in the days of Claudius Caesar.

ACTS 11:27-28

¹⁰And as we stayed many days, a certain **prophet named Agabus** came down from Judea. ¹¹When he had come to us, he took Paul's belt, bound his own hands and feet, and said, "Thus says the Holy Spirit, 'So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man who owns this belt, and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.' "

ACTS 21:10-11

Now this man **[Phillip]** had four virgin daughters who prophesied. - Literally reads: Now this man **[Phillip]** had four virgin daughters prophesying **[exercising the gift of prophesy]**.

ACTS 21:9

Prophecy, Word of Knowledge, Word of wisdom, Healings, Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues.

³But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.

I CORINTHIANS 14:3

¹“If there arises among you a prophet or a dreamer of dreams, and he gives you a sign or a wonder, ²and the **[verbally given]** sign or the wonder comes to pass, of which he spoke to you, saying, ‘Let us go after other gods’—which you have not known—‘and let us serve them,’ ³you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, **for**

the LORD your God is testing you to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. ⁴You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear Him, and keep His **[revealed]** commandments and obey His voice; you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him. ⁵But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams **shall be put to death,**

DEUTERONOMY 13:1-5

because he has spoken in order to turn you away from the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt and redeemed you from the house of bondage, to entice you from the way in which the LORD your God commanded you to walk. So you shall put away the evil from your midst.

DEUTERONOMY 13:1-5

¹⁹And when they say to you, “Seek those who are mediums and wizards, who whisper and mutter,” should not a people seek their God? Should they seek the dead on behalf of the living?

²⁰**[Go]** To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, **[the word of God]** it is because there is no light in them.

ISAIAH 8:19-20

¹⁸ I **[YHWH]** will raise up for them a Prophet **[Jesus]** like you from among their brethren **[specifically of the seed of David]**, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them **[the people]** all that I command Him. ¹⁹ And it shall be that whoever will not hear My words, which He **[Jesus]** speaks in My name, I will require it of him.

DEUTERONOMY 18:20-22

²⁰But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.’ ²¹And if you say in your heart, ‘How shall we know **[for sure]** the word which the LORD has not spoken?’—

DEUTERONOMY 18:20-22

²²[here's how] when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not happen or come to pass [in the prophet's lifetime], that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him.

DEUTERONOMY 18:20-22

²⁹Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others **[thoroughly]** judge.
