### **3 miracles only the Messiah could do**

- Heal a leper – Matt.8:2-4; Mark 1:40-45
- Cast out a demon out of a Mute man –  
Matt.12:22-24
- Heal a man born Blind – John 9

<sup>2</sup>And behold, a leper came and worshiped Him, saying, “Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.” <sup>3</sup>Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, “I am willing; be cleansed.” Immediately his leprosy was cleansed. <sup>4</sup>And Jesus said to him, “See that you tell no one; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.”

MATTHEW 8:2-4

<sup>44</sup>and said to him, “See that you say nothing to anyone; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing those things which Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.” <sup>45</sup>However, he went out and began to proclaim it freely, and to spread the matter, so that Jesus could no longer openly enter the city, but was outside in deserted places; and they came to Him from every direction.

<sup>13</sup>Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves to call the name of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits, saying, “We exorcise you by the Jesus whom Paul preaches.” <sup>14</sup>Also there were seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, who did so.

<sup>33</sup>Now in the synagogue there was a man who had a spirit of an unclean demon. And he cried out with a loud voice, <sup>34</sup>saying, “Let us alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the Holy One of God!” <sup>35</sup>But Jesus rebuked him, saying, “Be quiet, and come out of him!” And when the demon had thrown him in their midst, it came out of him and did not hurt him.
