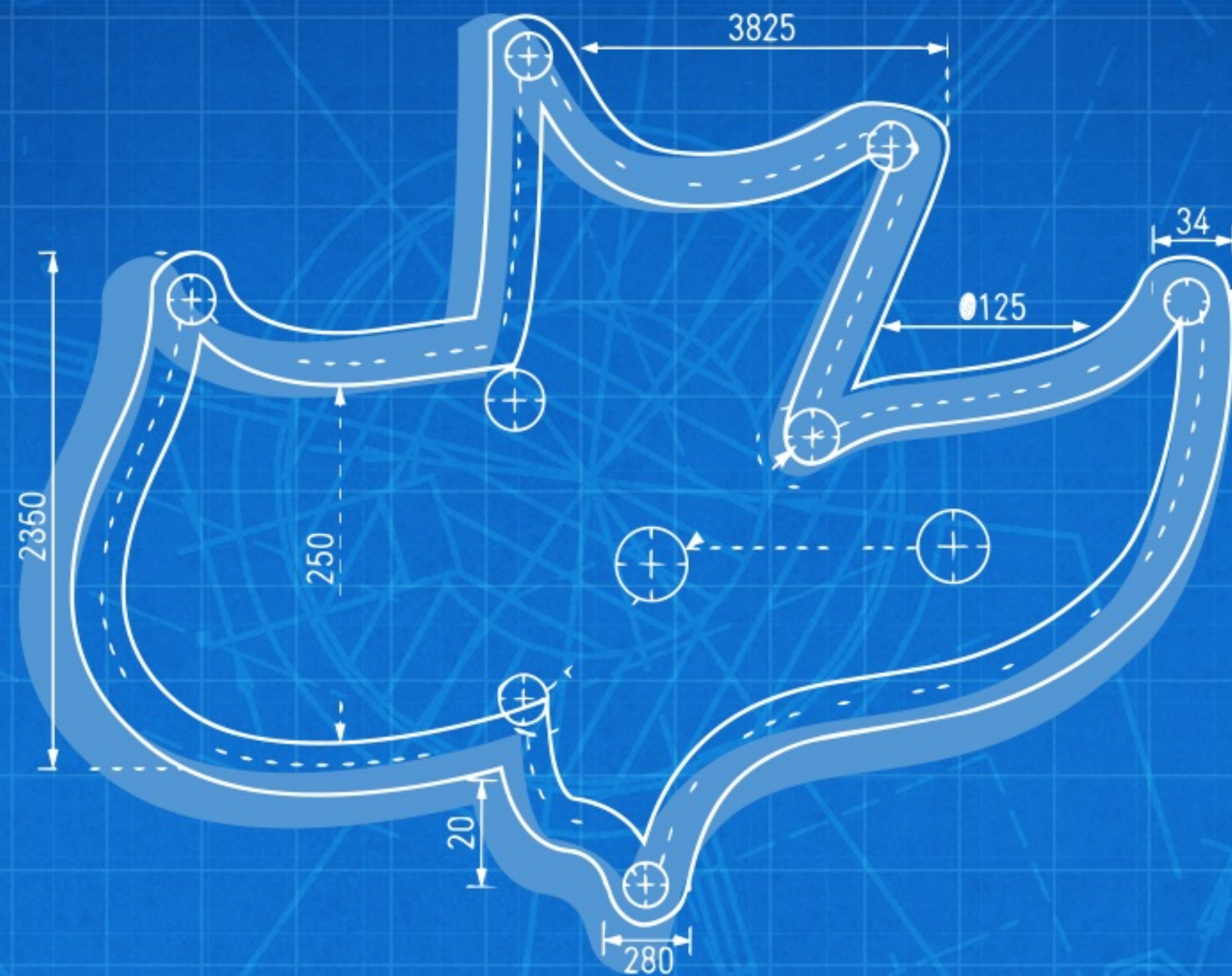




CALVARY**CHAPEL**DISTINCTIVES
