**Looked up** - Greek word - **ἀναλέπω**  
- **anablepo** to look up; by implication, to  
recover sight: KJV-- look (up), see, receive  
sight.

**Saw** – Greek word - *ἐμβλέπω* **em**

**blepo** – means behold, to gaze upon, to look upon and discern clearly.

<sup>1</sup>If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. <sup>2</sup>Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.

It was indeed, declared lawful to apply, for example, wine to the outside of the eyelid, on the ground that it may be treated in washing; but it was sinful to apply it to the inside of the eye. And as regards saliva, its application to the eye is expressly forbidden, on the ground that it was evidently intended for a remedy.
