Welcome!

We are very glad you've joined us for our study through the books of Hosea. We pray this study will serve as a tool to help you grow in your knowledge and understanding of our Lord and His Word.

Hosea is a warning to the Northern Kingdom of Israel. For over 200 years, the Jews living there had engaged in idol worship and further dishonored God by participating in meaningless rituals. Judgment and discipline were coming. They had ignored the prophets God had sent to plead with them to return to the Lord. They viewed their prosperity as God's approval and continued deeper and deeper into adulterous relationships with other gods.

The book of Hosea offers a unique look at the Holiness of God, accompanied by His long-suffering, grace, and forgiveness. Israel would face judgment for their idolatry, yet despite breaking the covenant they had with God, one day He would allure them into the wilderness, and there their relationship would change. "I will betroth you to Me forever; yes, I will betroth you to Me in righteousness and justice, in lovingkindness and mercy; I will betroth you to Me in faithfulness; and you shall know the Lord." Hosea 2:19-20
